Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners,

- Please have a safe and enjoyable Memorial Day weekend and let us take time to remember all who have given their life protecting the freedom we enjoy and defend throughout the world.
- Next Sunday is the Solemnity of the Ascension. Fifteen years ago many dioceses moved the celebration from Thursday to the Sunday Mass replacing the Seventh Sunday of Easter.
- I need to let you know that our parish expenses have exceeded our income. June is the last month of our fiscal year. If you are able to contribute more to Holy Rosary Parish to help us get in the black before the end of June 2019, it will be greatly appreciated. If you are behind in your contributions for the year and can contribute at this time, your tithe is needed.

Two major expenditures have contributed to the need: the rectory renovation and the former school building demolition. Money was collected for the demolition in a previous fiscal year and withdrawn from the 2018-2019 year. After consulting with our parish finance council, I took \$30,000 dollars out of our parish savings account to cover expenses for May 2019. In next week's bulletin, I will publish a summary of income and expenses so you have a report of our parish finances as we close the fiscal Thank you for your consideration and help in financially supporting your parish ministries.

On Saturday, June 15 Mass at Holy Rosary Church will be moved to St. Stephen Parish. There will not be Confessions or 5:30 PM Mass at Holy Rosary that Saturday. Mass will be outdoors at the St. Stephen Parish Pavilion to begin the 100th Anniversary Celebration for Knights of Columbus Council #1971 in Indian Creek. The Sunday Mass schedule at both parishes will stay the same.
