Dear Parishioners,

On this Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, we also celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with the third group of our high school youth. As Jesus ascended into heaven he empowered his apostles and disciples to, *“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all I have commanded you. And behold I am with you always until the end of the age.”* [Matthew 28:19-20]

Like the disciples, the newly confirmed, and each one of us, Jesus does not call disciples because we have absolute faith in Jesus or comprehend all Jesus teaches and expects of us. Jesus invites people whose faith wavers occasionally but whose knowledge and understanding of Christ grows as we spend time with Him in the sacraments and in prayer. The Greek word for disciple means “learner” and “follower” and that’s what we will do for the rest of our lives on our journey with Jesus until we meet Him in heaven. He has ascended into heaven and sent the Holy Spirit to be our help and guide, and then Jesus sends us forth to make disciples of all nations by our witness of Christ.

On this weekend when Jesus ascended into heaven, we pray for those who have died serving our country in the military. We remember their gift of self for the good of all the people of The United States of America and we pray that these valiant men and women have received the gift of eternal life in heaven.

Our parishes will honor those who have died serving our country and all who have died with a Mass at Holy Rosary Cemetery on Monday, May 25th at 9:00 AM (weather permitting). Please bring your own chairs and we will need to practice social distancing in the placement of the chairs.
