READINGS FOR MAY 26, 2019

The Sixth Sunday of Easter

1st Reading – Acts of the Apostles 15:1-2, 22-29 A controversy arose among the disciples whether or not gentile converts were to be circumcised according to Mosaic law. At a Jerusalem meeting the Holy Spirit, the apostles, and the elders decided gentiles should not be burdened by such laws.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 67:2-3, 5-6, 8 O God, let all the nations praise you!

2nd Reading – Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23 An angel carried the visionary to the top of a mountain to view the holy city Jerusalem coming down from God in heaven. There was no temple because the Lord God and the Lamb were the temple.

Gospel – John 14:23 Whoever loves me will keep my word, says the Lord, and my Father will love him and we will come to him.
